**Operational Fees are charged per family** and covers tuition, day-to-day costs (e.g. stationery, electricity, insurance, cleaning, maintenance), teaching resources (e.g. Library materials and computer hardware, software, and licensing fees), the Archdiocesan Education Levy (AEL), the Brisbane Catholic Education - Catholic Future Schools Land Acquisition Fund (CFSLAF) and goes towards any capital works and loan repayments. We are fortunate that our P&F Association financially supports the school in a range of areas.

**Student Levies are assessed per child** and encompass a range of activities, including swimming lessons, incursions, excursions, IT licences, and stationery for Prep students. The levy also covers transportation to local cluster events for students in upper year levels, as well as essential classroom resources particularly for early years where the consumption of materials is higher due to play-based and hands-on learning approaches, which necessitate increased operational expenditure.

The primary contributors to the higher levies in Years 3-6 are the costs associated with camps, greater participation in competitive interschool sports, Year 3 clarinet lessons, and extended student development activities. Year 6 leadership costs, including a senior shirt and end of year celebrations, are also covered within their levy. Additionally, the levy includes the cost of all student devices across the school with students in Prep to Year 3 utilising class sets of iPads, while those in Years 4 and 5 participate in a 1:1 iPad program and Year 6 students are provided with a 1:1 MacBook Air program. This enables individual responsibility for their assigned device supported by technical support, which is presently incorporated within this levy.
