Strong Catholic identity

Goal

St Elizabeth's will strengthen capacity to lead, engage and teach with a re-contextualised Catholic world-view within the school, Parish and wider community.

Actions

- Teaching staff will plan, assess and evaluate Religious Education units. (APRE/CT)
- Complete two half days of planning each term. (APRE/PLL)
- Teach manageable sized units that go for a 4-6 week duration. (CT)
- Students and families to attend special Masses at Mary Immaculate Catholic Church, Annerley. (WS)
- Year 6 leaders to attend various activities at Our Lady's College.
- Participate in various Caritas fundraising opportunities. (APRE)
- Review the specific purpose of special days. (LT)
- Consider new liturgically appropriate music for classroom celebrations. (APRE)
- Foster fortnightly Prep prayer with Parents. (CT)
- Review Holy Week activities. (APRE)
- Foster a "whole school" approach to meditation and mindfulness. (CT)
- Promote our school prayer and song. (APRE)

Excellent learning and teaching

Goal

St Elizabeth's School will grow engagement, progress, achievement and wellbeing for each student

Actions

- Teachers to continue to enhance the use of the Gradual Release of Responsibility Model.
- Focused use of the Context Text Model in planning and teaching.
- Continue to use all three high yield strategies with an enhanced use of the data from the data wall; refined review and response practises and implement learning walks and talks.
- Increased focus on literacy skills in particular writing and reading in line with our Literacy Smart Goal. (PLL)
- $\bullet\,$ Participation in the Relationships and Sexuality program.
- Basic mathematical facts practised daily within classrooms. (CT)
- Embed more use of spelling words in class and homework. (CT)
- Share the school's homework policy with the school community. (LT)
- Acknowledge Day for Daniel through free dress and teaching. (LT)

Actions

- Continue to provide positive parenting programs that support families in the home and school. (GC)

- Staff meetings to occur in different classrooms where the host teacher can "showcase" a particular aspect of their teaching. (CT)
